President*	Guide Cincinnati AEYC in management and policy-making decisions	Provide leadership to the Board of Directors by calling and presiding over meetings, orienting new members, ensuring on-going education so the Board can govern wisely and from the perspective of a high performing, inclusive organization aligned with National AEYC and Ohio AEYC, etc
Vice President - Support*	Support the professional development activities of Cincinnati AEYC	Oversee committees that provide support to members, communicating frequently with committee chairs, reporting on committee activities in the absence of committee chair, promoting CAEYC professional development activities, etc.
Recording Secretary*	Maintain official records of Cincinnati AEYC.	Prepare and provide written minutes of all meetings, prepare correspondence at the request of the Board, maintain Board records, etc.
Member at Large	Represent the membership in board actions and decision-making	Participate as an active Board member. Be responsive to the needs of Cincinnati AEYC members, assist with membership events, serve on at least two Board committees
